

LANE REPORT

LANE CHAMPION: Kyle Visconti

Generation Church is dedicated to changing the spiritual landscape of the entire east valley. We want to see lives changed for Jesus. Each of our campuses has a profound impact on their communities, and we are committed to resourcing and equipping them to accomplish the mission that God has set before us. To effectively further that mission, we must continuously address issues of capacity and functionality within our current and future facilities.

NEW WORSHIP CENTER

God is doing a powerful work through Generation Church. Our ministry is experiencing supernatural growth, and we're running out of room. We are in the process of constructing a new worship center at our Mesa campus that will allow us to fit twice as many families in our services. We need to create extra space so that people far from God can experience new life in Jesus.



MATHEW 9:37-38

"Then he said to his disciples, the harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore, pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest."

PHASE I: PARKING LOT

COST: \$1.4M - TIME: 12-16 WEEKS

There are currently 330 parking spaces on our campus. This means that we can really only host around 700 people total at our Mesa campus for any one service. Upon completion of phase 2, we will have 527 parking spaces with the ability to serve over 1,300 people (all ages) at our Mesa campus in a single service.


PHASE II: BUILDING

COST: \$4.8M - TIME: 8-10 MONTHS

In Phase II we will begin construction of our new worship center. Currently our main auditorium in Mesa can seat a maximum of 500 people per service. Our new worship center will have a main auditorium that will be able to seat over 1,200 people per service. Furthermore, the new worship center will relocate our little g's (ages 0-5) into the new worship center, which will make pick-up/drop-off of children much easier for our parents.

VISION GAP:

This provides a snapshot of the financial gap needed to fund the vision of the building project as a whole. Our church has already raised \$2.1M with a project gap of \$4.1M.



WHAT COULD BE ACCOMPLISHED IF THIS GAP WAS FILLED?

We could accelerate the timeline for launching campuses three and four by a minimum of one year. This would allow us to put campuses in low density church areas (*Low density compared to the relative population; areas like Queen Creek and Maricopa City) sooner. Furthermore, the less debt our church has, the more ministry we can accomplish.

THINGS TO PRAY FOR:

Pray that God will help our church receive supernatural favor with pricing and quotes even as material costs increase. Pray for the families who will have life-changing experiences in this new facility. Pray for the people in our community who need a church that is not ashamed of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

VISION PROJECT 2

RENOVATION OF FXISTING BUILDING

If you're physically in any one of our auditoriums on a Sunday morning, it's obvious that we need more auditorium space. What's less obvious, is that we need space everywhere else as well. As our church family grows, it grows proportionally across all our ministries. Our chapel services, gKids, little g's, Gen Z, Youth, and Young Adults all need more room for more ministry. We want to increase capacity for all of these ministries so that people far from God can experience new life in Jesus.

GKIDS RENOVATION

COST: \$285K

We want to renovate a portion of our existing auditorium in Mesa to become an awesome space that can host up to 200 children in a single service. This will give us plenty of room and

resources to teach our children about Jesus in a fun and simple way that helps them understand the relationship that our God wants to have with them.

CHAPEL RENOVATION

COST: \$240K

Our chapel services offer a more intimate and traditional style of worship. We want to increase our capacity for our chapel to accommodate services of 250 or more. To accomplish this, we'll renovate a portion of our existing Mesa auditorium to create a larger chapel venue.

THINGS TO PRAY FOR:

Pray for children to experience the love of Christ in a profound and life-shaping way in our children's ministry. Pray for the wisdom of our architect and engineers as we design this space to maximize the effectiveness of our ministry. Pray that hearts young and old would be changed forever in these spaces.

VISION PROJECT 3

SPECIAL NEEDS MINISTRY

Our lead pastors have a vision to ensure that those with special needs have a safe and welcoming place to worship together, to build authentic community, and to learn about Jesus. We want to be intentional about helping all of God's people experience the transforming love and grace of Christ so that people far from God can experience new life in Jesus.

SPECIAL NEEDS MINISTRY

COST: \$90K

To facilitate the goal of effectively ministering to our special needs church family, we want to create the space on our campuses with consideration to their varying needs and abilities. We would also like to hire a Special Needs Director, who will help us develop curriculum, train and

organize our special needs team members, and ensure the safety and care of all our church people. We want to help all members of our church learn God's word. We also want them to feel welcomed and loved.

THINGS TO PRAY FOR:

Pray for our Generation Church families with special needs children. Pray that they would remember that God has crafted them and their children for a kingdom purpose and that they are precious to God. Pray that God would send us the right Special Needs Director to champion this Ministry.

GLC STUDENT TUITION SCHOLARSHIPS

Generation Leadership College (GLC) is a vocational school that helps young adults to discover their purpose while developing their passion for the ministry. Students learn Christ-centered leadership skills in the classroom, the church office, and hands-on each Sunday directly from our staff. They also have the opportunity to seek a two or four-year degree through Southeastern University (SEU), which is a fully accredited university and Bible college within our network. We want to train the next generation of Christian leaders so that people far from God can experience new life in Jesus.



EPHESIANS 4:12-13

TUITION SCHOLARSHIPS

COST: \$10K

Finances are the greatest barrier to someone being able to go all in with their leadership journey at GLC. We would like to remove and reduce those barriers as much as possible, by providing 10 student GLC scholarships this year.

THINGS TO PRAY FOR

Pray for the families, workplaces, and churches that suffer from poor leadership. Pray that God will raise up our students to become dynamic leaders who understand how to effectively bring Jesus into business, government, churches, and their families.

Pray that God would use these scholarships to answer the prayers of our students, and to demonstrate His faithfulness to our young people.

GLC STUDENT MISSIONS SCHOLARSHIPS

According to the Global Project, young Christians who go on international missions' trips are 70% more likely to serve in their local churches and are 200% more likely to tithe. In addition, 90% of the most generous givers in church have gone on international missions trips and participate in a missionary support network. Sending young Christians on missions trips is a kingdom investment that is proven to yield a high EROI (Eternal Return on Investment) so that people far from God can experience new life in Jesus.

COST MISSIONS TRIP SCHOLARSHIP COST: \$30K

ROMANS 10:13-15

"For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. How then will they call on him in who they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? And how are they to preach unless they are sent?"

MISSIONS TRIP SCHOLARSHIPS

COST: \$30K

This year we want to help more GLC students experience international missions work than any previous year. Our goal is to help 20 GLC students with half the cost for the 2021 GLC student missions trip. We also want to help cover expenses for our other young adults who are wanting to participate in international missions trips.

THINGS TO PRAY FOR

Pray that God would use this trip to set young Christians on a life-long journey of Kingdom Building. Pray that God would use their trip to make a powerful impact in the lives of the people they are ministering to. Pray that God uses these scholarships to teach our young people that He will supply all of their needs.

Vision Project 1

Generation Food Pantry

Generation Food Pantry is open every Wednesday and Saturday. We feed



between 200 to 250 families per week and pick up food six days a week from multiple stores (Safeway, Target, Trader Joe's, Fry's, and more). The food pantry is affiliated with Saint Mary's Food Bank and has been designated as the highest performing food bank in their network of 68 food banks

across the valley. Generation Food Pantry is also the only food bank in Ahwatukee. Our food bank provides the opportunity for us to show the love of Jesus while meeting the physical needs of our community. We are dedicated to serving our community so that people far from God can experience new life in Jesus.

REFRIGERATED BOX TRUCK

Cost: \$40K

We want to serve an additional 100 families per week. Right now, the food pantry's operational bottleneck is refrigerated transportation space. A refrigerated box truck would allow us to transport more food in fewer trips so we could serve even more people in our community.

PART TIME DIRECTOR

Cost: \$35K/YEAR

The impact of Covid-19 on our community has required Generation Food Pantry to more than double its weekly throughput. To meet the increased demand, we want to hire a part-time director to help manage the food pantry's high tempo day-to-day operations.

THINGS TO PRAY FOR

Pray that God would send people to our food bank who are hurting and need a Savior. Pray that God would help us to meet the increased demand and to serve the people of our community who need it the most. Pray that the food pantry demonstrates Jesus to the people we are serving. Pray for our leaders and workers to be healthy, strong, and full of Jesus' love as they serve. Pray that God would provide the necessary resources to serve the families of our communities.

Vision Project 2

Backpack Outreach



For the last five years Generation Church has served our community at our annual Backpack Outreach where we provide backpacks, supplies, and back to school clothes for families who are in need. We also give them food, treats, haircuts and so much more. Within this outreach, we are also able to support OCJ

Foster Group Homes and provide them with much needed supplies. Most importantly, during the event, we provide an easy-to-understand gospel message, and every year, people accept Jesus! This ministry has grown each year. In 2020, even in the midst of covid pandemic, we were able to bless families in our community so that people far from God can experience new life in Jesus.

2021 BACKPACK OUTREACH OCJ FOSTER GROUP HOME SUPPORT

Cost: \$15K

This year, we want to demonstrate the love of Jesus to as many foster children as possible. OCJ Foster Group Homes care for 12-15 foster children. This year, we want to support 15 homes and supply over 200 foster children. This support will have a huge impact on these precious kids by providing needed school supplies and clothing items.



THINGS TO PRAY FOR

Pray that God would use our backpack outreach to communicate the love of Jesus to our community. Pray that the foster kids who receive our supplies would know that they're valuable and that they are loved. Pray that little hearts would make big decisions to serve Jesus when they hear the gospel at this event.

VISION PROJECT 3

CHOSEN FOSTER AND ADOPT MINISTRY

In response to the Biblical command to care for the fatherless, Generation Church established Chosen -- our Foster Care and Adoption Ministry. The goal of this ministry is to encourage families in their calling to care for foster children or adopt children in permanent need of a family. As a cornerstone ministry of Generation Church, Chosen will draw resources from all areas of the ministry and will partner with external ministries to support foster and adoption families. In addition, Chosen will provide training for people to become a CASA, a mentor, a wraparound family, or a part of our GC Support Team. We also want help support OCJ Group Foster in the form of training and resources so that people far from God can experience new life in Jesus.

CHOSEN FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Cost: \$50K

CONVOY OF HOPE

COH's Disaster Services Team is consistently among the first to respond to disasters at home and around the world. Every year, they serve millions of people affected by natural and man-made disasters. This is done through partnerships with local churches, businesses, government agencies, other nonprofits, and our incredible donors and volunteers. It's our desire to see life-giving churches in every community fighting hard to alleviate both spiritual and physical poverty. Generation Church continues to partner with exceptional churches and missionaries in countries all over the world to help them reach the lost. We provide encouragement and support for church planting, leadership development, social impact (health and education), and economic development initiatives. In 2020 Generation Church gave over \$193K to support our Global Missions and local outreach partners during this challenging season.

PARTNERING WITH THE PANGELINANS



Johnny and Andrea Pangelinan, along with their three children, are missionaries in Thailand. They have a Godgiven passion to reach the people of Thailand for Jesus. Thailand is a predominantly Buddhist country. Christians make up only .5% of the Thai population. Thailand has one of the lowest church densities per capita in the world. They have 7,000 provincial districts, and in 71% of those regions, there isn't a single Christian church. Additionally, in Thailand, the sex trade is a \$7 billion a year industry and that number grows every year.

Thailand desperately needs Jesus. The Pangelinan's ministry works to grow existing churches, plant new churches, build Christian Schools, and combat sex trafficking so that people far from God can experience new life in Jesus.

BUS MINISTRY OUTREACH IN THAILAND COST: \$5K

Johnny and Andrea help facilitate a robust "crusade style" bus ministry that has effectively projected the reach of their ministry into unchurched districts. We want to support this endeavor by helping to update their equipment and by covering the costs of fuel and maintenance for one year.



CHIANGKHAM CHRISTIAN SCHOOL PLAYGROUND COST: \$3K



The Pangelinans help run a group home for girls and a Thai Christian school! At this school there is currently no playground for the children. We want to help build a playground for them that will help illustrate the bible at a whole new level. We want to help them build a "Noah's Ark" themed playground to bring one of the Bible's most iconic stories to life.

THINGS TO PRAY FOR

Pray for the safety of the Pangelinans as they minister in Thailand. Pray that God would open doors all over the nation for them to reach people. Pray for the salvation of the people of Thailand. Pray that their eyes would be opened to the truth of who Jesus Christ is. Pray that God would open doors for the bus outreach and that many would choose to follow Jesus.

VISION PROJECT 2

MOROCCAN WELL

Connie Huffer has been a missionary to the Middle East and North Africa for the past 31 years. She currently serves on the leadership team for the entire Arab world. She's also dedicated to mentoring new missionaries, planting new churches, and passionately sharing Jesus with women throughout the Muslim world. This last year, the Covid 19 pandemic has only exacerbated the political, economic, and health related problems that the Moroccan people were already experiencing. Connie is helping a pastor from one of the nearby villages, which is in need of clean water. We want to demonstrate the love of Jesus by meeting a real need for these people so that people far from God can experience new life in Jesus.

MOROCCAN WELL

COST \$2.5K

We want to demonstrate the love of Jesus to the people of Morocco by raising funds to dig a well that provides clean drinking water, meeting a very tangible need.

THINGS TO PRAY FOR

Pray for the safety of Connie as she brings the light of Jesus to one of the spiritually darkest regions in the world. Pray that God would use this well to help reveal his love and truth to these people in a tangible way. Pray that God uses the fulfillment of physical thirst as an opportunity to satisfy spiritual thirst.

VISION PROJECT 3

CUBA MISSION TRIPS AND PROJECTS

God has opened a great door of opportunity for evangelism in Cuba. After several mission trips there, we have a special place in our hearts for the Cuban people. We've been a part of building churches, Bible schools, and have facilitated a children's ministry to thousands of Cuban children; but the need in Cuba is still great. Also, the average income is incredibly low at \$11/month. There are also very few churches in Cuba so the people there are struggling to survive physically and spiritually. Our ministry dollars go a long way in Cuba. The funds we provide will supercharge kingdom expansion, enabling us to build churches, mobilize pastors, and reach the people of Cuba at an exponential level so that people far from God can experience new life in Jesus.



EPHESIANS 2:19-22

"So, then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit."

TEAM CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

COST: \$10K

We want to support four existing construction projects that had shoestring budgets even before material costs skyrocketed in the last six months. There are currently four pastors in Cuba that don't know how they are going to complete their churches and are praying that God would make a way so that they can get back to winning the lost. We're asking God to use us to be the answer to those prayers.



NEW CHURCH BUILDING

COST: \$50K

This project is going to fully fund the construction of a building for an existing church that has no building at all. For their own development, a team from GLC will assist with part of this project.

TEAM TRIP

COST: \$20K

We'd like to take a mission's team into Cuba to assist in construction, church outreach, and children's ministry.

PASTORAL SALARIES

COST: \$5K

The Communist Cuban Government has shut down churches and public gatherings



throughout the country making it increasingly difficult for Cuban pastors to sustain their respective ministries. In Cuba, medical doctors make \$30/month. We know God uses pastors to do spiritual surgery, so we think it would be appropriate to pay Cuban pastors commensurately. We want to help cover the salaries of 13 pastors in Cuba (at the M.D. rate) for an entire year.

THINGS TO PRAY FOR

Pray that God would allow restrictions to be lifted for travel to Cuba so we can resume our efforts there. Pray that God would provide for the churches and the Pastors. Pray for the people of Cuba who have suffered under the oppression of communism for over 60 years and are especially suffering from the effects of COVID-19. Pray that God would provide resources and people so we can take teams into Cuba and reach the people there with the love of Jesus.
