

OUR STORY & HISTORY

Generation Church launched in 2014 after long-time pastor Randy Visconti felt it was time to entrust the church to his son, Ryan. Pastor Ryan and his wife, Pastor Amy, have led Generation Church in alignment with the church's name ever since.

In June 2017, New Life Church in Ahwatukee, established in 1991 and led by Pastor Amy's parents, Paul and Beth Lavino, joined Generation Church and became the South Mountain Campus. Similarly, in October 2021, Generation merged with Fountain Hills Christian Center, which became the Fountain Hills Campus. Both churches, which brought decades of ministry to their prospective communities, were now supercharged by the vision and mission given by God to Pastors Ryan and Amy.

Across all of its campuses, Generation has been focused on its mission to Honor God, Equip Believers, and Reach the Lost. We honor God by being true to His word even when it's socially uncomfortable or even dangerous. We equip believers by creating ministry environments where attendees are regularly challenged to step out of complacency and taught to take an active role in being

the type of Christian outlined in scripture. We passionately <u>reach</u> the lost by inviting friends, family, neighbors, and coworkers to hear the good news of Jesus, supporting missionaries and ministries around the world, taking an active role in supporting the foster and adoption community in Arizona, and so much more. Through these efforts and the grace of God, we have seen a doubling of new believers year after year.

We believe God has uniquely equipped Generation Church and its leadership to be effective in pointing people toward Jesus and challenging other pastors and leaders across the country to increase their boldness in how they communicate the Gospel in our current culture.

We are excited to see how God continues to write the story of Generation Church and what He will do across the Greater Phoenix area, the nation, and even the world.



1948 ORIGINAL GC

Our church origins go back to 1948, when Desert Community Church A/G started over on Main Street. They eventually moved to our current property on Ellsworth, changing names a few times over the years, and eventually becoming Generation Church as it's known today.



1991 NEW LIFE CHURCH ESTABLISHED

Paul and Beth Lavino, moved from Illinois to Ahwatukee to plant New Life Church which they led for 26 years. The present South Mountain campus was built during their tenure.



1999 CELEBRATION CHURCH ESTABLISHED

Randy and Dawn Visconti became the pastors of Celebration Church in 1999 (meeting at what is now the Mesa campus). Pastor Ryan came to work for the church as an executive pastor in 2011.



2014 GENERATION CHURCH ESTABLISHED

In 2014, Pastor Ryan and Pastor Randy discussed relaunching Celebration Church and renaming it "Generation Church."



In 2017, we launched the South Mountain campus in Ahwatukee following a merger between Generation Church and New Life Church.



GENERATION CHRISTIAN ACADEMY

At Generation Church, we're committed to raising up future generations in Christ, which is why part of the funds from the 1,000 Generations initiative will go toward the groundwork for a Christian school—Generation Christian Academy. This project will start with laying a strong foundation, which includes pursuing certification, hiring key staff to build the framework, and exploring potential facilities. Our vision is to create an educational environment where academic excellence meets spiritual growth, giving children the tools they need to thrive in both their faith and their futures.

MESA GKIDS SPACE

Our gKids ministry has grown so much that we have run out of space in the old gKids auditorium. Part of the 1,000 Generations initiative will go toward renovating our old auditorium into our new gKids space. This will include areas for small groups, large gatherings, and a new play structure.

QUEEN CREEK CAMPUS

The launch of our Queen Creek Campus represents an exciting opportunity to expand our reach and relieve some of the capacity pressure at our Mesa campus. Many of our members already call Queen Creek home, and by establishing this new campus, we can bring the heart of Generation Church closer to them while also reaching new families in the growing Queen Creek community. This new campus will enable us to boldly share the gospel, build strong families, and meet the needs of a community in Arizona's fasting growing area.

The Queen Creek Campus will launch with a portable, set up and tear down system located in a local school. This strategy has been proven successful and will allow us to launch the campus quickly. One of the exciting elements of a system like this is that it can be reused for future portable campuses for years to come.
